Turnout Horse Blanket – Choosing The Perfect Turnout Blanket For Your Horse

A **turnout horse blanket** is a very important requirement in caring for your horse. Although there are many types of blankets that are intended for horse use, there is of course a particular type that will perfectly fit your horse's needs depending on the current situation.

Choosing the right turnout blanket for your horse simply relies on the kind of weather. For example, the warmer the weather is the lighter the blanket should be; in the same way that when the weather turns out to be cold, the heavier one should be given to your horse.

The following are the three classifications of a turnout horse blanket:

Lightweight – this is known as the sheet; it is commonly worn by horses during warm weather conditions

Medium Weight – type of a horse blanket that is commonly used during cold weather

Heavy Weight – a kind of horse blanket that is commonly worn by horses during extremely cold weather conditions

For your information, medium and heavy weight horse blankets often come with fillings for the purpose of giving more warmth to the animal. On the other hand, lightweight blankets are considered as plain sheets only without any fillings at all.

If there is a need for you to shop for a turnout horse blanket you need to distinguish the word “denier” on the item with a number that appears beside it. The number simply indicates the size of the blanket or the number of yarn filament that was used to make the blanket. When the number increases this would simply mean a heavier characteristic of the blanket.

Basically, a turnout horse blanket is usually used by horses that are in the cold and spend much of their time in the pasture. This type of blanket is usually made from waterproofed materials. It is also designed to be resistant from any twisting conditions most especially when the animal wants to roll around and over the ground. Basically speaking, a turnout horse blanket is much similar to a stable blanket.

Depending on the coldness of the weather, you can simply add more layers or fillings of the blanket. Say for example, in a place where there is winter, a horse owner can simply try the above-mentioned suggestion to give more warmth and comfort to his horse whenever temperatures drop at very cold or frigid levels.

Think of this whenever you are choosing a turnout blanket for your horse: you have to determine how old the horse is as older horses may require you to give them warmer blankets while the younger ones simply need the lighter ones. Considering all these things will truly make a perfect choice for your horse's blanket needs.

There are also **turnout horse blankets** and sheets that can be worn by the horse while it is in the stable or animal stall. Usually, they are not made from waterproof materials so they should not be worn by horses when they are turned out in pasture or in the paddock. All of these are good for your horses and there is no reason why shouldn't allow your horse to make use of them.
