# **Winter Horse Blanket Reviews – Simple Guidelines To Help You Decide On The Right Blanket For Your Horse**

Whenever you are shopping for **winter horse blankets**, it is very important to refer to winter horse blanket reviews online. As a matter of fact, these reviews are very essential in your search for the right blanket for your animal.

Animals are just like humans; they also feel the cold weather and giving them with the right protection will simply make them feel comfortable and would prevent them to suffer from the harsh effects of the ever-changing weather conditions. With blankets, your horses get the right protection they need whenever the weather turns out to be cold or bitterly cold.

The winter season is a difficult season for animals like horses. With this regard, it is imperative that we should also give them the right protection they need to fight off the weakening effect of the extremely cold weather.

Well here are 2 types of winter horse blankets which you may want to buy for your horses:

1. Stable blankets
2. Turnout blankets

When we say stable blankets, they are usually blankets that are considered very warm. They are usually designed to provide warmth and comfort rather than the feature of maneuverability. Generally, these types of blankets are usually worn by horses whenever they are inside the stable or stall (it's also the reason why they are called stable blankets). And when the temperature drops to an extremely cold level, you may want your horse to use these blankets outside the stable.

Whenever the temperature drops below the freezing point, it will be very important and necessary for your horse to make use of stable blanket and is layered by a turnout rug especially when the horse is outside. But before you do this, you have to consider the fact that one horse may differ from the others. The older the horse is, the heavier and warmer its blankets should be and the younger the horse is the lighter the blanket should also be.

Now if your horse is being clipped, you have to know that blankets are the only ways you can separate their skin from the triggering coldness of the temperature; and it's the only way you can protect them whenever cold weather conditions arise.

Below are some guidelines for you to know if your horse is too cold:

- stands stiffly in a tensed manner
- the horse tail is firmly tucked to its body
- shivers
- hair stands on end
- goose bumps
- no signs of warmth in the body if you run your hands through its ears, face, etc.

If the horse is too warm it may:

- sweat! This is an indicator that your horse wears too much blankets
- if the shoulder area is sticky and wet, the horse is too warm

Checking the comfort of your horses is very important during cold weathers and you should do your routine checkup few times a day. Depending on the age and other characteristics of your horse, you should make it a point to consider such characteristics so that you may know when is the right time to put on **winter horse blanket** on them.
